Relative Clauses

DEFINITION

Relatives Pronouns (**who, whom, which, whose, that**) introduce relatives clauses. We use relative clauses to identify the noun in the main clause.

e.g. The man **who owns the shop** is French.

Relative clause

(The relative clause identifies which man we are talking about)

WHO / THAT

We use **who / that** instead of the subject pronoun to refer to people.

e.g. : The girl - she lives next door - is from India.

The girl **who / that** lives next door is from India.

WHICH / THAT

We use **which / that** instead of the subject pronoun to refer to objects or animals.

e.g. : The horse - it won the race - is black.

The horse **which / that** won the race is black.

WHOSE

We use **whose** instead of possessive adjectives with people, objects and animals in order to show possession

e.g. : That's the man - his car was stolen.

That's the man **whose** car was stolen.
